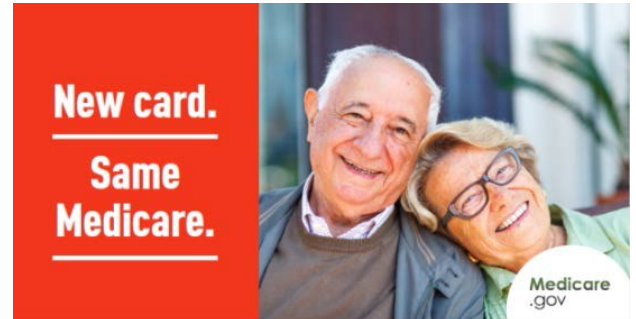


New Cards for Medicare Members

CENTERS FOR MEDICARE & MEDICAID SERVICES (CMS) ISSUING NEW CARDS

Beginning April 2018, CMS will be issuing and mailing new Medicare Cards. The new cards will no longer include your Social Security Number (SSN), but will include a new unique Medicare Number. Your coverage and benefits will remain the same.



As you can imagine, there are many cards that CMS needs to mail. Their effort will begin in April of 2018, but you personally may not receive your card for several months. During this transition period, providers will still be able to use both your SSN and the new Medicare Number.

There is nothing you need to do. CMS will automatically send your new card. However, you can make sure your information is current. If you need to update your address, visit <https://ssa.gov/myaccount> or call 1-800-772-1213.



Remember that the cards will be mailed. CMS will not be making any calls. If you receive a call unexpectedly saying they “work with” or represent Medicare and need your card Number or other personal information, hang up! Protect yourself from scams: <https://medicare.gov/fraud>.
